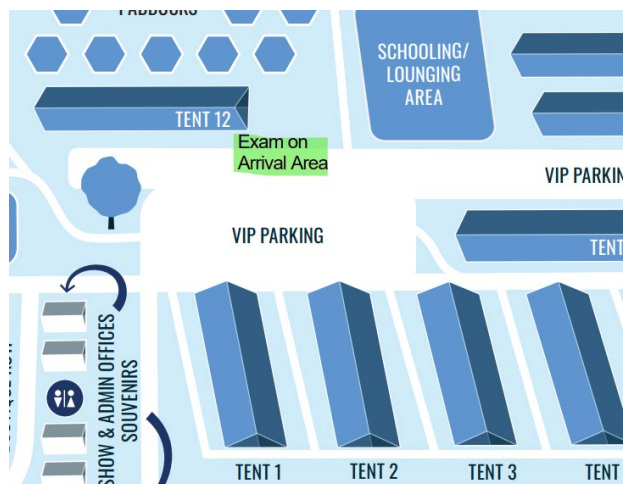




Veterinary Examinations on Arrival

NAYC FEI Stabling will open on **Monday, August 8th**. Examinations on arrival will be conducted between **9:00am and 5:00pm**. Horses must complete the exam on arrival prior to entering the NAYC Stabling Compound. Failure to do so may result in elimination from the Event.



Horses will be stabled by zone/region/country.

NAYC Horses arriving prior to Monday, August 8th will be placed in National Stalls until their FEI Stall is ready.

Exams on arrival for CS13* horses on property from previous weeks **not changing stalls** will be conducted on Monday, August 8th from 7am-9am. Vets to check horses in their stall.

NAYC Horses – Prior to Entering FEI Stabling Must Complete Exam on Arrival

Proceed to Examination on Arrival Area (East West Vet Tent) between 9:00am and 5:00pm. Person checking in the horse must bring the horse's passport, a thermometer, and ensure that temperatures have been logged in the FEI Horse App, twice a day, three days prior to arrival, and the Self Certification Form has been completed.

Veterinarian checks passport, and scans microchip. Person Responsible takes horse's temperature with thermometer that they brought. Member of the horse's support team should be available to hold horse when temperature is being taken. Veterinarian logs temperature into the FEI horse app.

If horse has an elevated temperature it will be placed into isolation stabling and temperature will be rechecked. Any horses traveling with a horse that is presented with an elevated temperature will also be placed in isolation stabling until cleared by the veterinarian.

Passports are kept with the OC for the duration of the Championships.

Once the horse has passed the Exam on Arrival, they may enter the NAYC Stabling Compound.
